Pet ready quarantine checklist

Emergency Care

- Designate someone to look after your pets if required
- Write a pet diary for each pet's history, routines and quirks
- Contact boarding or pet minding facilities and pre fill out paperwork if possible
- Keep pet carriers and leashes close at hand
- Ensure your pet has a secondary form of identification such as collar and tag
- Ensure vaccinations are up to date
- Prepare an emergency contact list with phone and email details



Food and Medications

- 2-4 week supply of food for each animal and feeding instructions
- 4 week supply of medications and parasite prevention
- 2-4 week supply of cat litter
- 2-4 week supply of poo bags, pee pads or an indoor grass potty



Documents

- Vaccination certificate
- Microchip information
- Registration
- Medical history and summary (if possible)
- Up to date photo of you and each pet
- Contact details for your local vet, alternative vets, emergency contacts and boarding facilities
